

- Leading figures: M. Luther, J. Calvin, H. Zwingli, Henry VIII.






### The Lutheran Reformation

- in Germany
- **1** 95 Theses
- reform of church and society



## The Calvinist Reformation

- In Switzerland around the big cities (Zurich, Berne, Basle)
- So called Reformed church

- Switzerland
- M Huldrych Zwingli
- Person should be baptized only when is adult
- "Left wing of the Reformation"






#### The Catholic Reformation

Group of responses against the "Protestant reformation"


Reforms in Catholic church
