


#### **French Presidential Election**





#### **Systems of Governance**



- Yellow Presidential republics with a semi-presidential system
- Green Parliamentary republics with an executive presidency responsible to the legislature
- Orange Parliamentary republics with a ceremonial/executive president, where a separate head of government leads the executive
- Red Constitutional monarchy with a ceremonial monarch, where a separate head of government leads the executive
- Magenta Constitutional monarchy which have with a separate head of government, but where royalty still hold significant executive and/or legislative power
- Purple Absolute monarchy
- Brown Countries where the dominant role of political party is codified in the constitution
- Dark green Countries in which constitutional provisions for government have been suspended (e.g. military dictatorship)
- Grey Countries which do not fit any of the above systems (e.g. transitional government or unclear political situations)
- Light grey No government



- actions that affect the well-being of members of a society through shaping the distribution of and access to goods and resources in that society

Principles of social justice, human rights, collective responsibility and respect for diversities are central to social work.
