• Why are you angry with me? What have I done?

• Are you angry about last night? (= something that happened last night)

• Ann is very different from her sister.

• I'm fed up with my job. I want to do something different. (= I've had enough of my job)

• The room was full of people.

• Are you good at maths?

• Tina is very bad at writing letters.

• I'm not interested in sport.

• Sue is married to a dentist. (= her husband is a dentist)

• It was kind of you to help us. Thank you very much. • David is very friendly. He's always very nice to me.

• I'm afraid I can't help you. I'm sorry about that.

• I'm sorry for not phoning you yesterday. (or I'm sorry I didn't phone you)

preposition + -ing

After a preposition (at/with/for etc.), a verb ends in -ing:

stories. I'm not very good at telling the same thing every day? Are you fed up with doing I'm sorry for not phoning you yesterday. Mark is thinking of buying Tom left without saying

a new car. goodbye. (= he didn't say goodbye) the shopping, they went home.
